Rules and Regulations – PLEASE READ THEM CAREFULLY THEY ARE FOR YOUR SAFETY

1. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL IN ALL RESPECTS

2. NO FEES ONCE PAID ARE RETURNABLE. UNLESS CLASS IS CANCELLED BY THE ORGANISERS

3. SWEARING OR ABUSE DIRECTED TOWARDS A JUDGE OR CLUB REPRESENTATIVE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. ANYONE DOING SO WILL BE BANNED FROM THE SHOW.

4. ANY OBJECTIONS MUST BE MADE IN WRITING, WITHIN 15 MINUTES OF THE INCIDENT ALONG WITH A REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT OF £40.00 IF SUSTAINED DEPOSIT WILL BE RETURNED TO THE COMPLAINTANT.

5. ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEAR A PROTECTIVE HELMET WHENEVER MOUNTED, ALSO UNDER 16 YEAR OLDS MUST WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMET DURING ALL IN-HAND EVENTS.

6. CORRECT DRESS AND FOOTWEAR MUST BE WORN IN ALL EVENTS - NO PLIMSOLS OR TRAINERS IN RIDDEN CLASSES.

7. NO SPURS TO BE WORN ON PONIES UNDER 14.2HH, VETERANS OR M&M CLASSES. NO SPURS TO BE WORN BY RIDERS UNDER THE AGE OF 16 UNLESS WRITEN APPROVAL GAINED FROM THE COMMITTEE GRANTED FOR MEMBERS ONLY ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS. ABUSIVE USE OF SPURS OR WHIPS WILL LEAD TO YOU BEING DISQUALIFIED AND ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND.

8. WHERE THE HEIGHT OF A HORSE OR PONY IS IN DISPUTE A HEIGHT CERTIFICATE WILL BE REQUESTED. PASSPORTS SHOULD ALSO ACOMPANY THE HORSE OR PONY TO THE EVENT AND BE PRESENTED IF REQUESTED

9. NO UN-AUTHORISED PERSON TO ENTER RINGS.

10. ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CANCEL OR COMBINE CLASSES IF THERE ARE INSUFFICIENT ENTRIES. OR SPLIT CLASSES IF HIGH ENTRIES

11. COMPETITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BEING READY AT THE CORRECT RING WHEN REQUIRED, IF YOU ARE IN ANOTHER RING PLEASE NOTIFY THE JUDGE OR THE COMMITTEE IN THE CARAVAN. THE JUDGE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DECIDE WETHER TO WAIT OR NOT. NOT BEFORE TIMES WILL BE ADHERED TO BUT CLASSES MAY RUN LATER KEEP AN EYE ON YOUR RINGS.

12. ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SUBSTITUTE OR CHANGE JUDGE IF NECESSARY.

13. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AND UNDER CONTROL POO MUST BE PICKED UP OR YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

14. YOU MAY ONLY ENTER 3 SUCCSEESIVE JUMPING CLASSES; I.E. BEGINNERS, NOVICE, NOVICE PLUS NOT BEGINNERS, NOVICE, OPEN. 15. HORSES / PONIES LESS THAN 4 YEARS CANNOT COMPETE IN RIDDEN CLASSES.

16. LEAD REIN MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE NOSE BAND AND LEADERS MUST BE OVER 16 YEARS OF AGE

17. ANY HORSE / PONY NOT UNDER PROPER CONTROL BY THE RIDER / HANDLER WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE RING AND IF CONSIDERED DANGEROUS TO SPECTATORS OUTSIDE THE RING WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND

18. ANY PERSON NOT COMPLYING WITH THE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND / OR ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND. 19. ORGANISERS ACCEPT NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ACCIDENTS / INJURY / LOSS TO SPECTATORS / COMPETITORS OR ANIMALS.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE MEMBERS CHAMPIONSHIP YOU MUST HAVE BECOME A MEMBER PRIOR TO THE DAY ON WHICH THE SHOW IS HELD OTHER THAN THE FIRST SHOW OF THE SEASON WHERE YOU MUST BE A MEMBER BEFORE YOUR CLASS COMMENCES. MEMBERS ARE ISSUED A COLOURED BACK NUMBER TO BE WORN FOR THE DURATION OF THE SEASON. THE HIGHEST PLACED MEMBER IN RINGS 1-4 WILL GO FORWARD TO THE MEMBERS SUPREME OF SHOW.

23. PLACING ROSETTES WILL BE AWARDED TO 6TH IN ALL CLASSES. SPECIAL ROSETTES AWARDED TO RING CHAMPIONS AND RESERVES AND GALRLAND SASHES FOR SUPREME AND RESREVE SUPREME OF SHOW WITH PRIZE MONEY AS ADVERTISED PRE SHOW. MINI SUPREME AND RESERVE WILL RECEIVE A SASH OR SPECIAL ROSETTES FOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE. MEMBERS SUPREME OF SHOW WILL RECEIVE A LARGE ROSETTE OR SASH.

24. PLEASE USE THE WORKING IN RING PROVIDED WARM UP JUMPS ARE TO BE USED CAREFULLY AND BY PEOPLE IN JUMPING CLASSES ONLY. PLEASE LUNGE SENSIBLY IN THE WARM UP RING EARLY IN THE DAY IF THE WARM UP BECOMES BUSY WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DISSALOW LUNGING.

25. NO TROTTING OR CANTERING IN WALKWAYS OR THE CAR PARK USE THE WARM UP RING - PERSISTANT OFFENDERS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND. THIS INCLUDES THOSE WARMING UP FOR INHAND.

26. PLEASE ENSURE WHEN STANDING OUTSIDE OF RINGS YOU ARE NOT CROWDING GATEWAYS INTO THE RINGS AS THIS IS A HAZARD FOR HORSES ENTERING AND EXITING CLASSES. IF YOU ARE TOO CLOSE TO A GATEWAY YOU WILL BE ASKED TO MOVE AND PERSISTANT FAILIURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOU BEEN ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND

The New Ilkeston and District Riding Club 2022 Schedule

Ring 1 Ridden Showing 9.30am Prompt Start

All horse and ponies must be 4 years and over to compete in ridden showing. All rider's must be of correct size and weight for the horse or pony they are riding. All ages apply from the 1st of January 2022. All classes are open to mares, geldings and Stallions. Stallions must be ridden by a rider who is 14 years or over.

Class 1, Ridden M&M Large Breeds- Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies which are registered to the breed society Fell,Dales,Connemara,Highlands,New forest, Welsh C and D's. To be shown by breed society regulations. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 2, Ridden M&M small Breeds- Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies which are registered to the breed society Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh A and B's. to be shown by breed society regulations. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 3, Ridden Veteran- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony 15 years or over. Includes LR – See class 4 for rules ESUK, STARS (highest 14 -19 and highest 20+ to represent)

Class 4, Ridden Plaited Pony - Open to ponies of hunter or show pony type not exceeding 153cm. Includes LR- see class 4 for rules. All horses MUST be plaited. ESUK, STARS

Class 5, Lead Rein Pony- Open to M&M small breeds, SHP, SP and ANY other type. Pony must not exceed 128cm. Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st of January. Snaffle bridles only and lead rein must ne attached to the nose band. ESUK, STARS (highest M&M and Plaited to represent) Class will be split if sufficient pre - entries

Class 6, First Ridden/ First Year First Ridden Pony- Open to M&M, SHP, SP and ANY other type. Pony must not exceed 138cm. Riders must not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st of January. Snaffle bridles only. WALK AND TROT in the go around only, cantering in individual show is optional. ESUK, STARS (highest M&M and Plaited to represent) Class will be split if sufficient pre entries

1st and 2nd from classes 5 and 6 are to go forward for the Mini Championship at the end of the day not the ring championship

JUDGES LUNCH BREAK 30 MINS

NOT BEFORE 12PM

Class 7, Ridden Plaited Horse - Open to horses of hack/riding horse/hunter type exceeding 153cm. All horses MUST be plaited. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 8, Ridden Open Horse or Pony- Open to ALL types of Horses and ponies inc LR - see class 4 for rules. ESUK Will be split horses/pony's if pre - entries allow

Class 9, Ridden ex racehorse- Open to TB's. Must have been in training or raced registered with Weathersby. Any type and any height. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 10, Ridden Coloured- Open to ALL skewbald and Piebald's horse and ponies. Any type and any height. includes LR- see class 4 for rules. ESUK, STARS (highest Plaitted and Cob/native/Trad to represent)

Class 11, Ridden Native, Traditional, Cob- Open to ANY height horse or pony. To be shown natural or hogged. Solid or colored. Includes LR – See class 4 for rules ESUK, STARS

Class 12, Ridden Alternative Colored - Open to ANY height Horse or Pony Spotted, Dun, Palomino, Roan. Includes LR – See class 4 for rules. **ESUK**

Any competitors placed 1st or 2nd from classes 1 – 4 and 7 - 11 are eligible for Ridden Championship this will run at the close of the ring.

The Champion and Reserve will then go on to compete in the Supreme of Show at the close of all rings.

<u>Ring 2</u> In Hand Showing

All Horses and Ponies must be safely handled, if any animals is deemed dangerous or out of control you will be asked to leave the ring. This ring is Open to any age Horse or Pony. Fillies, Colts and Stallions must be handled by someone over the age of 14 years old. Stallions MUST be bitted.

Handlers under 16 years old MUST wear a helmet.

9.30am Prompt Start.

Class 13, Young Stock- Open to Any Type of horse or pony 3 years and under. To be shown to type. Handlers to be 16 years and over. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 14, In Hand Plaited Type- Open to ANY height horse or pony. MUST be plaited. **ESUK, STARS (Highest Horse and Pony to represent)**

Class 15, In Hand Coloured- Open to Skewbald and Piebald's, ANY type Horse or Pony. **ESUK, STARS (Highest Pony and Horse to Represent)**

Class 16, Alternative coloured Horse & Pony- Open to ANY type of horse or pony, Spotted, Dun, Palomino, Roan. Class will be split if entries warrant. **ESUK**

Class 17, Open Horse & Pony- Open to ANY type of horse or pony. Class will be split if entries warrant. **ESUK**

JUDGES LUNCH BREAK 30 MINUTES

NOT BEFORE 11.30 PM

Class 18, In Hand Native, Traditional, Cob- Open to ANY height horse or pony. To be shown natural or hogged. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 19, Inhand ex racehorse- Open to TB's. Must have been in training or raced registered with Weathersby. Any type and any height. **ESUK**,

Class 20, M&M Large Breeds- Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies which are registered to the breed society Fell, Dales, Connemara, Highlands, New forest, Welsh C and D's. To be shown by breed society regulations. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 21, M&M small Breeds- Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies which are registered to the breed society Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh A and B's. To be shown by breed society regulations. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 22, In Hand Veteran- Open to ANY height horse or Pony 15 years or over. ESUK, STARS

Class 23, Mini Young Handler- Handler must not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st of January. Open to Mares and Geldings 4 years or over. To be judge on the handlers ability and not on confirmation. Hard hats MUST be worn. **ESUK, STARS (Highest Tiny Tot and young to Represent)**

Class 24, Junior Handler- Handler to have attained their 12th birthday but not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st of January. Open to Mares and Geldings 4 years and over. Hard hats MUST be worn. **ESUK, STARS**

1st and 2nd from classes 23 and 24 are to go forward for the Mini Supreme of show not the ring championship

Any competitors placed 1st or 2nd from classes 13 - 22 are eligible for In Hand Championship this will run at the close of the ring.

The Champion and Reserve will then go on to compete in the Supreme of Show at the close of all rings.

Ring 3 Working Hunter

All horse and ponies must be 4 years and over to compete in Working Hunter. All rider's must be of correct size and weight for the horse or pony they are riding. All ages apply from the 1st of January 2022. All classes are open to mares, geldings and Stallions. Stallions must be ridden by a rider who is 14 years or over. All classes have a maximum height guide. If ground conditions are at their best our judges have the right to put every fence to maximum height. Horses and Ponies will run and be placed together. You can only enter 3 consecutive classes in one day.

8.00 – 9.00 am Clear Round Jumping 45cm – This will close at 9am prompt for the first class to commence £2 per round payable at the caravan or on booking in.

9am Class start

Class 25, Cradle Stakes-Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm. Riders to not have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st of January. includes LR. Max height of fences 25cm **ESUK, STARS (Highest LR to represent)**

Class 26, Nursery Stakes- Open to ponies not exceeding 133cm. Riders to have not attained their 12th birthday before the 1st of January. Max height of fences 35cm. ESUK, STARS (highest combination under 10 and under 128cm to represent)

Competitors who gain a 1st or 2nd placing from classes 25 and 26 are to come forward for our Mini Supreme of Show not the ring championship.

Class 27, Beginners- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony Canter will be optional in this class. max height of fences 40cm

Class 28, Riding Club Horse or Pony-May be split if enough entries. Open to ANY type of horse or pony. Show piece must incorporate 2 jumps of the competitor's choice from the course max height 50cm **ESUK, STARS (highest Horse and Pony to represent)**

JUGES LUNCH BREAK 30 MINUTES

NOT BEFORE 11.30pm

Class 29, Novice- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Max height of fences 50cm

Class 30, Novice Plus- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Max height of fences 60cm ESUK, STARS (Highest 'Pony under 133cm' and highest M&M small breed to represent)

Class 31, Intermediate- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Max height of fences 70cm ESUK, STARS (Highest 'Pony over 133cm but under 153cm and highest M&M Large Breed to represent)

Class 32, Open- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Max height of fences 80cm ESUK, STARS (Highest horse Exc. 153cm to represent)

Any competitors placed 1st or 2nd from classes 27- 32 are eligible for the Working Hunter Championship. This will take place after the last class of the day

The Champion and reserve will then go forward for the Supreme of Show once all the rings finish

<u>Ring 4 Variety Ring</u>

All horse and ponies must be 4 years and over to compete as a ridden combination. All rider's must be of correct size and weight for the horse or pony they are riding. All ages apply from the 1st of January 2022. All classes are open to mares, geldings and Stallions. Youngstock can be shown in hand. Youngstock and Stallions must be ridden by a rider who is 14 years or over.

10.00AM Prompt Start

Class 33 Tack and Turnout- Open to ANY age rider and any height horse or pony. Judge on cleanliness of horse, tack and rider. **ESUK, STARS**

Class 34, Junior Beginners Showing- Open to ANY type of horse or pony. Riders to not have attained their 16th birthday before the 1st of January. WALK AND TROT ONLY. This is for true novice and nervous riders. Any height horse or pony can be competed on lead rein or with assistance in the ring. Please enter in the spirit it's intended for. **ESUK**

Competitors who gain a 1st or 2nd placing from this class are eligible for our Mini Supreme of Show not the ring championship

Class 35, Senior Beginners Showing- Open to ANY height horse of pony. Riders to be over 16 years old. WALK AND TROT ONLY. This is for true novice and nervous riders so please enter in the spirit its intended for. **ESUK**

Class 36, Ridden Novice Horse or Pony- Open to any type horse of pony and any rider. This is for novice and nervous horses not necessarily novice riders CANTER OPTIONAL. ESUK

JUDGES LUNCH BREAK 30 MINUTES Not Before 12pm

Class 37, Equitation- Rider any age. Open to ALL types and ages of Horses and ponies inc LR - see class 4 for rules. You will be required to perform a set show that will be decided by the judge on the day of the show. This may include Serpentines, Rein back and Halts. These classes are not judged on confirmation but you are required to be correctly turned out and dressed. **ESUK, STARS** (highest LR, FR, junior and senior to represent) Highest placed LR and FR from this class are eligible for our Mini Supreme of Show

Class 38, Cutest Combination – Open to any age or height horse or pony. Riders any age. In hand or Ridden. **ESUK**

Class 39, Handsome Gelding – Open to any age or height horse or pony. Riders any age. In hand or Ridden. **ESUK**

Class 40, Pretty Mare – Open to any age or height horse or pony. Riders any age. In hand or Ridden. ESUK

Class 41, Concours – Open to any age or height horse or pony. Riders any age. In hand or Ridden to be shown in either evening wear or period costume. ESUK, qualifier for the concours de elegance society of GB championships.

Any competitors placed 1st or 2nd from classes 33, 35- 41 are eligible for the Variety Championship. This will take place at the end of the classes. The Champion and reserve will then go forward for the Supreme of Show

Once all 4 Showing Rings Have finished, we will run our overall Championships at Approx. 4pm in the following order:

Members Supreme

Highest placed members from all classes in all 4 rings to come in walk round and line up will be awarded based on who judges feel have tried hard, shown good sportsmanship and achieved the most that day not necessarily the best show horse. Champion and reserve go forward to the Overall Supreme

Mini Supreme

(1st and 2nd from classes 5, 6, 23, 24, 25, 26, 34)

Highest LR and FR from class 37

Champion and Reserve will go forward to the Overall Supreme

Overall Supreme of Show

<u>Ring 5</u> Show Jumping

Fastest double clear from classes 42 – 45 and from 47 – 50 will each receive the showjumping championship sashes. Horses and Ponies will jump together and be placed together. Horses and Ponies must be 4 years or over. You can only compete in 3 consecutive classes.

9.30 – 10.30am Clear Round 40cm will close at 10.30 prompt for the start of the first class £2 payable at the caravan or on booking in.

10.30am prompt Start

Class 42, Lead Rein- Open to ponies not exceeding 138cm riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st of January. Max height of fences 25cm.

Class 43, Juniors- Open to ponies not exceeding 148cm riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st of January. Max height of fences 35cm

Class 44, Beginners- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. Max height of fences 45cm

Class 45, Novice- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. Max height of fences 55cm. **ESUK**

Class 46, Style and Performance Jumping - Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. This class will be judged on style and performance whilst jumping. A mark out of 10 will be given at each fence with marks for rhythm, position and balance. Fences 55cm.

NOT BEFORE 12.00pm

Class 47, Novice Plus- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. Max height of fences 65cm. **ESUK**

Class 48, Intermediate- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. Max height of fences 75cm. **ESUK**

Class 49, Sheridan's Fun class - Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. This class will be Sheridan's choice of class, could be higher and higher, could be wider and wider, could be narrower and narrower or something else Sheridan comes up with!

Class 50, Open- Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. Max height of fences 85cm. ESUK

Class 51, Open Accumulator - Open to ANY height Horse or Pony. Rider ANY age. Fences will increase in height as you go around the course each fence is worth its fence number in points if jumped clear. The last fence will be a choice of 2 fences one at 90cm and a joker at 1.05m the joker gains 50 points if jumped clear but if faulted at will loose 50 points. **ESUK**
